## Vermilion Well Re-Entry & Repair Project

Preparations have started for the Orphan Well Association's (OWA) Re-entry and Repair project. The playground equipment and trees have been removed from the park located between 63<sup>rd</sup> and 64<sup>th</sup> Streets in the Brennan sub-division. ATCO has also been doing work in the area including de-energizing the overhead power lines and laying armoured cable on the ground.

The OWA will be starting lease preparation on September 8<sup>th</sup>. With this in mind, here is some information that may be of interest to community residents.

**Getting your mail** – The Canada Post superboxes located on 63<sup>rd</sup> and 64<sup>th</sup> Streets will be relocated to 50<sup>th</sup> Avenue between 63<sup>rd</sup> and 64<sup>th</sup> Streets before September 8<sup>th</sup>. They will be returned to their previous locations once the OWA's operations are completed.

**Garbage Pick-up** – Garbage pick-up will remain as is on Friday mornings. Residents may continue to put their garbage bins curbside the evening before or in the morning. Please remove the bins from the curb early in the afternoon if possible.

**Where to Park** – No on-street parking will be allowed on 64<sup>th</sup> Street for the duration of operations. Residents can park in their driveways. There may be intermittent parking restrictions on 63<sup>rd</sup> Street and 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. Signs will be posted when parking restrictions are in effect.

**Hours of Operation** – Plans call for operations on site to run from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday to Friday and 8:00 am to 8:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday. However, on occasion specific activities may require the work day to be extended. OWA commits to ending operations no later than 9:00 pm. Generators may be required after hours to power safety equipment.

**Local Traffic** – Traffic on 63<sup>rd</sup> and 64<sup>th</sup> Streets and 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue between 63<sup>rd</sup> and 64<sup>th</sup> will be restricted to local traffic only. Signs will be posted. There may be brief road closures on 64<sup>th</sup> Street on the days when the larger equipment is being moved. Residents may be asked to check in with Security staff when they enter or leave the area. This will ensure residents and visitors are safe while moving through the area of the operation.

**School Bus Pick-up & Drop-off** – Effective September 8<sup>th</sup>, the school bus stops on 64<sup>th</sup> Street will be slightly adjusted to ensure student safety. The stops will be temporarily moved to in front of 5209 64<sup>th</sup> Street and 5243 64<sup>th</sup> Street. On-site personnel will also restrict the movement of trucks and equipment on 64<sup>th</sup> Street during school bus pick-up and drop-off times.
