Friday, September 15, 2017 - Crews purged surface lines with nitrogen to make it safe to disconnect the lines from the well. This work is needed to provide safe access to the well head for next week's abandonment operations.

On Monday, September 18, crews will be bringing equipment onsite to prepare for well abandonment operations. The equipment, called slick line, will be used to open the sub surface valve (downhole safety valve) so that water can be pumped into the well to prevent any gas from the well from coming to surface. This is known as killing the well. Once this is done, two down hole plugs will be set inside the tubing, so that the wellhead can be safely disconnected and the service rig can be brought in for the well abandonment.
